The pursuit of the Kings forces continued by Col. Generall Poyntz, eleven Knights and Colonels, eleven Lieut. Colonels, six Majors, twenty seven Captaines, fourteen Lieutenants, seven Correts, five Quarter-masters, taker. 800 slaine, 1500 prisoners, and 2000 horse taker. Sir Thomas Fairfax advanced with 9000 horse and foot toward Exeter, Lieutenant General Cromwell entering Winchester, and besieging the Castle. A Bill of all such as have been buried of the plague in Bristol the last weeke.
