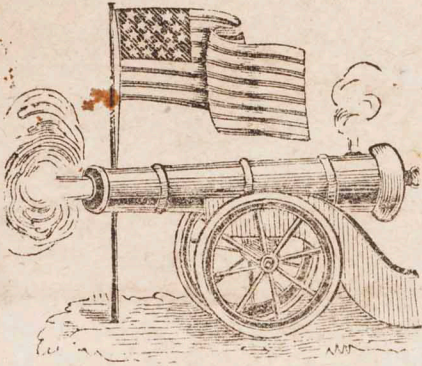

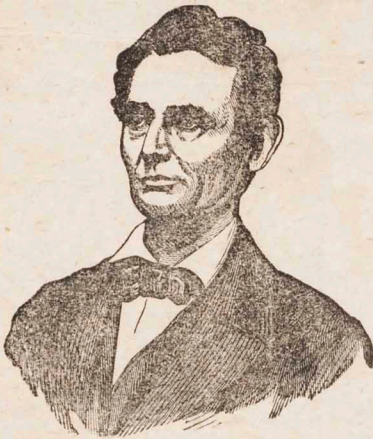

The returns from the interior of the State were procured by Mr. U. H. Painter, Superintendent of the Telegraph line.

PENNSYLVANIA.—Schuylkill county gives 1500 for Lincoln—a gain of 865 over Curtin. Snyder 650 for Lincoln. Union gives 1100 for Lincoln. Franklin county gives 1100 for Lincoln. In Tyrone City—Blair county—Lincoln's majority is 25, a gain of 3 for the Fusionists,

Huntingdon Boro'—Lincoln gains 65 over Curtin.

Lancaster City gives 88 majority for Lincoln. There were 276 straight Douglas votes.

Danville—Lincoln gains 78. Dauphin county—1600 majority for Lincoln. Harrisburg gains 200 over Curtin's vote.

Mount Joy Borough, gives Lincoln 490 majority—a heavy gain.

Lancaster county 8000 for Lincoln. Allegheny county—10,000 for Lincoln.

Berks county 1000 for Fusion—a great gain for the Republicans.

Westmoreland—100 to 150 for Lincoln. Union county—437 maj for Lincoln.

Centre county—500 majority for Lincoln. Brooklyn city, N. Y., gives 10,000 for Fusion.

Philad'a, Nov. 6, 10.00 P. M.—It is rumored here that Speaker Pennington is defeated.

12.45 A. M.—The following dispatch has just been received from Gov. SEWARD, from Auburn:—"I assert from reliable authority, that Lincoln has carried the State of New York by 60,000 majority. Lincoln's election is conceded on all hands."

Philad'a, Nov. 7, 1.30 P. M.—New York City gives 28,194 against Lincoln.

Messrs. Wood, King, Taylor and Ward, all loco-focos, are elected to Congress from New York city. Eli Thayer is reported to be defeated in Massachusetts by the regular Republican nominee.
